behavior agreement

We pray each trip participant knows God and is striving to live a life worthy of His calling. Paul gives solid guidelines in Ephesians 5:1-4 on how to live: "Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving."

BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES:

I understand that...

- I. I will not purposefully damage or destroy property belonging to other students or leaders.
- 2. I will not purposefully damage or destroy equipment, materials, or facilities.
- 3. I will not be disrespectful or disobedient to adult leaders.
- 4. I will not publicly display affection (PDA). (consequences depend on severity)
- 5. I will not maliciously harass, tease or criticize anyone.
- 6. I will not dress improperly or wear the following:

*extremely tight tops or bottoms

*tops that bare the midriff

*spaghetti strap tops or low-cut shirts

*short shorts

*clothing that pictures or advertises substances that are illegal by law for minors or that are

violent or suggestive in nature

*shorts that sit low so that underwear is showing (boys and girls)

*bikinis (one piece only)

- 8. I will not leave the property.
- 9. I will not physically hurt or harass someone.
- 10. I will not use or possess tobacco, alcohol, or any other type of illegal drug.
- II. I will not dishonor separate arrangements for males and females.
- 12. I will not disobey any laws established by our student handbook.

BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT:

Parents, please read these guidelines with your children. Each student and his/her parents must agree to these guidelines to attend the North Cobb Christian Fall Retreats. If the rules are not followed, the parent of the student will be contacted. If there is a serious violation, the parent must come and pick their student up from camp immediately so as to maintain the integrity of the retreat for the other participants.
